

## DRINKING DRIVER

### *Program*

The Drinking Driver Program (DDP) is an Educational program which is sponsored by the State of New York Department of Motor Vehicles. The program is designed to provide information to motorists convicted of alcohol and drug related offenses.

The program consists of two parts. The first part is 16 hours of education for those meeting the referral criteria. The second part consists of an assessment process with the possibility of further education and/or treatment.

## COMMUNITY RESIDENCE

### *Program*

The Trapping Brook House is a 15-bed Halfway House Facility certified by the State of New York Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services. Trapping Brook House is designed to help adult males in their recovery process from alcoholism and chemical dependency.

## SUPPORTIVE LIVING

### *Program*

The Supportive Living Program is a 15-bed Apartment program certified by the State of New York Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services for persons who have completed a residential program at a Halfway House or Recovery Care Home.

### FEES:

All program services except the Prevention Department are covered by Medicaid and third-party insurances. Clients without such coverage are assigned fees on a sliding scale and based on ability to pay.

### CONFIDENTIALITY:

A client engaged in any type of counseling is guaranteed absolute confidentiality. This right is guaranteed to all clients under Federal Confidentiality and HIPAA Laws. Information may not be released without the client's written consent.

## OUTPATIENT SERVICES

Allegany Council provides multidisciplinary treatment to any person either referred or self-directed who meets admission criteria. This program is certified by the State of New York Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services to deliver clinical treatment services to individuals and families whose lives have been affected by alcohol and/or chemical dependency. Full-time counselors are available to deliver a wide range of services. These include:
